



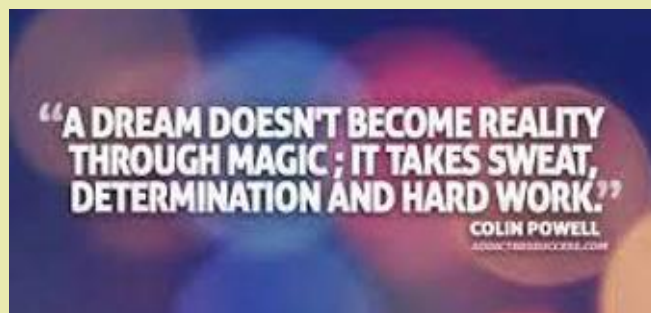
A Message from Campus PHC Executive Director, LPN...

Welcome to May!! We have a lot going on this month with the transition of our new owners Magnolia Senior Living, we welcome them and look forward to developing their structure in Personal Care.

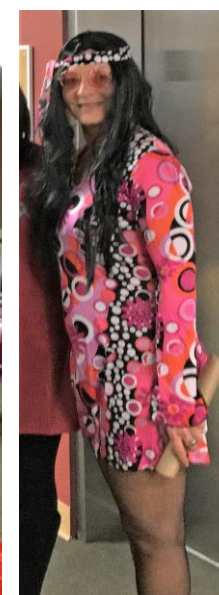
